

Report on Committee on International Laws 2017

This is a new committee set up by the Bar to deal with increasingly prominent issues of international laws that the Bar is invited to comment and contribute. Members of this committee have significant knowledge in international laws. This year, we have, first, encouraged members to attend courses on international laws including those organised in Hague. Secondly, this Committee has commented on a number of legislations which has an international laws dimension including reciprocal enforcement of civil and commercial judgments between the Mainland and Hong Kong.

This Committee will continue to respond to issues concerning international laws and to facilitate education on international laws for members who are interested in this area.
