Report on Standing Committee on Overseas Admissions 2018

- 1. As of 31 December 2018, there were a total of 31 applications for the admission of overseas counsel to practise as a barrister in Hong Kong on an *ad hoc* basis, as compared to 23 in 2017. Of the 31 applications, 7 were for criminal cases.
- 2. This year the Standing Committee consented to 27 applications, 6 of which were criminal cases. It opposed 4 applications, including 1 criminal case. Of these 4 applications, the Court allowed one and dismissed one, with 2 pending,
- 3. The total number of applications allowed by the Court was 23 (of which 6 were criminal cases).
