

Report on Standing Committee on Pupillage and Limited Practice 2018

The Standing Committee on Pupillage and Limited Practice is responsible for processing applications and handling enquires about the rules, practice and procedure in respect of pupillage and admission.

During the 12-month period from 1 December 2017 to 30 November 2018, a total of 108 pupils commenced their pupillage (as compared to 98 in the previous reporting period). The total number of pupils who either have completed or are serving pupillage amounted to 206 (as compared to 185 in the previous reporting period). 121 (as compared to 105 in the previous reporting period) of them have been admitted as barristers, of which 108 was admitted in the current reporting period (as compared to 87 in the previous reporting period).

The Standing Committee has processed a total of 725 applications (as compared to 606 in the previous reporting period) which were received in different stages of the pupils' training.

I am indebted to the members of the Standing Committee, Edwin Choy SC, Jennifer Tsui, Tony Li and Eric Leung for their prompt and invaluable advice and contribution. I also thank Peace Lau and Jessica Lam for their support in handling the constant workload of the Standing Committee.
